What is it?

A third party audit is an independent and objective appraisal of your business management systems. Advice and recommendations are made to improve your business processes. Business management systems, whether they be quality, environment or health and safety based are focused on continual improvement of processes and activities. Third party auditing can ensure this continual improvement and can help you maintain an effective system which is suitable for your business needs.

Why do it?

A third party audit can identify areas for action, which can often be overlooked during day to day activities. Regular auditing enables you to:

- check that your procedures are running efficiently and are streamlined to meet the business requirements of your organisation;
- ensure that your ISO requirements are met. If your management system is certified to an ISO standard, regular audits are mandatory to maintain the standard;
- identify problems early so that preventative and corrective measures can be put into place;
- identify relevant legislation and any areas of non-compliance.
